SCATTERING OF ASHES

FEES to be received by Great Baddow Parish Council for the scattering of ashes of cremated remains:

For the scattering of ashes of cremated remains in the Garden of Remembrance £80.00

For the scattering of ashes of cremated remains over grave for which the exclusive right of burial has been granted £80.00

REGISTRATION AND SEARCHES

FEES for searches of register books and for copies and extracts to be taken:

Every search covering a period of not more than one year £24.00

Every search covering a period of more than one year:
for the first year £24.00
for every additional year £24.00

Every certified copy of an entry of burial in the register books £ 7.00

GARDEN OF REMEMBRANCE

Memorial bush rose and metal plaque displayed for 5 years £277.00

Renewal further 5 years £228.00

Additional metal plaque for rose bush £125.00

Memorial standard rose tree and metal plaque displayed for 5 years
£355.00

Renewal further 5 years £262.00

Additional metal plaque for standard rose £125.00

TRANSFER OF DEED

Transfer of the Exclusive Right of Burial £90.00

GREAT BADDOW PARISH COUNCIL ACTING AS THE BURIAL AUTHORITY IN RESPECT OF LAWN CEMETERY AND OLD BURIAL GROUND

FEES APPLICABLE FROM 1ST DECEMBER 2018

The fees, payments and sums set out overleaf apply:

- where the person to be interred was, immediately before death, an inhabitant or parishioner of the Parish of Great Baddow or the Parish of Galleywood
- where the person to whom the exclusive right of burial is to be or has been granted, is an inhabitant or parishioner of the Parish of Great Baddow or the Parish of Galleywood
- in the case of a stillborn child, where the parents (or one of them) are, or at the time of interment were, such inhabitants or parishioners.

In all other cases, the fees, payments and sums will be doubled, except that those set out in Parts 2 & 3 will not be doubled where the exclusive right of burial in the grave in question, or the right of constructing the grave or vault, was acquired at the single fee as set out in Part 1.

NEW REGULATIONS

Reservations for plots will no longer be taken from people who reside outside the parishes of Great Baddow or Galleywood (subject to special circumstances), and should it be necessary to surrender a reserved plot prior to use, a sum amounting to 50% of the fee paid will be refundable.

Where a parishioner is required to leave the parish for medical reasons, they will continue to be regarded as a parishioner, for burial purposes, for a period of two years, or longer at the Clerk's discretion.

PART 1

EXCLUSIVE RIGHT OF BURIAL IN EARTHEN GRAVES

In the Lawn Cemetery/Old Burial Ground

1. For the exclusive right of burial:
For a period of 50 years
 - (a) in an earthen grave 9 feet by 4 feet
(Old Burial Ground 7' x 3'). £912.00
 - (b) in an earthen grave 6 feet by 3 feet (children) £224.00
2. For the exclusive right of burial of cremated remains for a period of 50 years in an earthen grave 2' 6" by 2' 6" £433.00
3. For the renewal of the exclusive right of burial for a further period of 25 years, half the fees indicated in terms 1 and 2 shall be payable. The exclusive right of burial cannot be renewed until the date of expiry.
4. For a plot purchase prior to need, the fees shown in 1 and 2 will be doubled

PART 2

INTERMENTS

In the Lawn Cemetery/Old Burial Ground

1. For the interment, in a grave, in respect of which an Exclusive Right of Burial has been granted:
 - (a) of the body of a still-born child, or a child whose age at the time of death did not exceed 4 years £57.00
 - (b) of the body of a child whose age at the time of death exceeded 4 years but did not exceed 16 years £155.00
 - (c) of the body of a person whose age at the time of death exceeded 16 years £325.00
2. For the interment of cremated remains in a grave in respect of which an exclusive right of burial has been granted, or in a grave set aside for the purpose. £119.00

PART 3

MONUMENTS, GRAVESTONES, TABLETS AND MONUMENTAL INSCRIPTIONS.

In the Lawn Cemetery/Old Burial Ground

1. For the right to erect or place on a grave in respect of which the exclusive right of burial has been granted:
 - (a) A headstone or stone cross (includes first inscription) £170.00
 - (b) A headstone on a child's grave £47.00
 - (c) A tablet on a grave set aside for the interment of cremated remains (includes first inscription) £93.00
 - (d) A free standing vase £14.00
 - (e) In the case of cremated remains plots, a metal frame and/or bonded chippings, if not applied for at the same time as the tablet £19.00
 - (f) Additional inscriptions (after the first) on any monument £60.00
 - (g) Additional inscriptions on headstones in the Children's Section £19.00
 - (h) Any other work (including cleaning, re-lettering and/or repair) to any monument, gravestone, tablet or inscription £19.00
- Old Burial Ground ONLY
- (i) A headstone or stone cross not exceeding 5 feet in height £171.00
 - (j) Headstone or stone cross, exceeding 5 feet in height, For each additional foot or part thereof an additional £ 6.00
 - (k) Kerb stones or border stones enclosing a space not exceeding 7' by 3' and not exceeding 6 inches in height, with corner stones not exceeding 12 inches in height. £100.00

OTHER FEES

- For the topping up of cremated remains graves £34.00
- To dig a cremated remains plot for interment £62.00

Please note that in both Lawn Cemetery and Old Burial Ground, only stonemasons registered with the Burial Authority may undertake work.
